1. Request

The request should be POSTed (rather than GETed) to the above URL.

Required variables are in **bold**.

Optional variables are in *italics*.

Variable Name (case insensitive)	Type	Max. Length	Description
loginName	string	64 chars	Account Username (case sensitive).
loginPassword	string	128 chars	Account Password (case sensitive).
orderNumber	integer		The Order Number of a non-EV certificate which qualifies for the Free EV Upgrade offer.
<i>caCertificateID</i>	integer		If specified, this overrides Comodo's default choice of CA certificate/key to be used to issue the Free EV Certificate. This functionality is only available by special agreement with Comodo.

Note 1: Each Free EV Certificate will default to using the CSR that was provided for the qualifying non-EV certificate. To provide a new CSR, use the !AutoReplaceSSL API.

Note 2: We require various additional information in order to successfully validate an EV certificate. The !ProvideEVDetails API may be used to provide this information.

2. Response

The MIME type will be `application/x-www-form-urlencoded`, because the format of the response will be the same "URL-encoded" format as the request (e.g. `name1=value1&name2=value2`).

Variable Name (case insensitive)	Type	Description
errorCode	integer	Error code (see list below for possible values).
<i>orderNumber</i>	string	The Order Number for the Free EV Upgrade (if the Upgrade was applied successfully). This will normally be the same as the original Order Number with "evup" appended.
<i>errorMessage</i>	string	Explanation of error.
<i>errorItem</i>	string	The problematic request parameter (this is relevant to errorCode -2, -3 and -4).

Here are the possible values for "errorCode" and "errorMessage":

errorCode	errorMessage
0	Successful
-1	Request was not made over HTTPS!
-2	'xxx' is an unrecognized argument!
-3	The 'xxx' argument is missing!
-4	The value of the 'xxx' argument is invalid!
-14	An unknown error occurred!
-16	Permission Denied for <reason>! Contact Support
-17	Request used GET rather than POST!
